



## **Uniform Policy**

**Updated January 2026**

We believe that our uniform is a very important part of our school as it provides our pupils with an identity and signals a belonging and commitment to our school community. By wearing a smart uniform, it reflects the high standards and expectations that we set for ourselves and each other throughout the school. Our uniform must be practical as well as smart to ensure we have a uniform that allows our pupils to comfortably engage in all elements of our curriculum and school day.

### **Uniform Policy**

Please ensure your child arrives ready for school correctly dressed in the correct uniform and that it is clean and in good repair. Please ensure all of your child's belongings are clearly labelled with their name.

Clothing should be suitable for the weather, including coats when cold or wet.

### **Day to Day Uniform – up to Year 5**

Yellow polo shirt, which can be plain or with Hanwell Fields logo

Grey trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafore dress (Ladybirds and Caterpillars can wear joggers or leggings)

Summer dresses (yellow (ideally) or navy check) will be also acceptable in Terms 4-6.

Navy blue jumper or fleece, this is the only piece of uniform that we ask has the Hanwell Fields logo

Grey or white socks

Black (plain) footwear

- Footwear must be practical so that a child is comfortable in them when running or outside in moderately wet conditions
- Leather or fabric trainers are allowed but they **MUST** be plain black – no coloured stripes or logos
- Boots are not allowed
- Footwear must be flat, no heels

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### **Year 6**

As above, except Year 6 wear a pale blue shirt and school tie.

### PE Uniform

All PE uniform is to be plain navy, with or without the Hanwell Fields logo.

Please avoid patterns, stripes, or any large logos. No hoodies allowed (except Year 6 leavers hoodies Term 5-6)

Indoor: Plain or school logo navy t-shirt, navy shorts or trackpants/jogging bottoms, trainers (any colour)

Outdoor: Recommended: school jumper or fleece with logo. Or plain navy zip through or tracksuit top, navy trackpants/jogging bottoms, trainers (any colour)



### Forest School

Same as PE but everything must be long-sleeved – plain navy joggers not shorts, plain or school logo navy long sleeve t-shirt.

### Haircuts

Whilst we want children to be able to choose their hairstyle, we ask that it is not too extreme.

### Jewellery

Watches and stud earrings (only one stud per ear) are the only jewellery permitted in school. These must be removed for PE and swimming. Children are responsible for looking after their own items and must be able to remove watches and earrings themselves.

It is at the headteacher's discretion that any hairstyle or item of clothing may be banned if deemed to be in breach of this policy.

Uniform and book bags may be purchased from suppliers (details below).

PE kit (which can also be used for forest school) with a logo can also be purchased from our uniform suppliers.
